2. Only the bidders who have supplied and successfully commissioned at least one hydropower project in Nepal with installed capacity not less than 2.5 MW as a main electromechanical supplier in last five years are eligible for bidding.

4. A pre-bid meeting shall be held, if necessary, at National Hydro Power Company Limited office, in Binayak Nagar, Kathmandu at an appropriate time.
5. Sealed bids with hard copy as well as electronic copy must be submitted to the office of National Hydro Power Limited, Binayak Nagar, Kathmandu by hand/courier on or before 23rd April, 2023 during office hours. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
6. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 15:00 hours on 24th April, 2023 at the office of National Hydro Power Company Limited Binayak Nagar, Kathmandu.
7. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security, which shall be valid for a minimum of 60 days beyond the bid validity period.
8. If the last date of purchasing and/or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case, the validity period of the bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
9. Bidders shall need to visit the site and assess the actual site conditions before submitting their bids.
10. The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject, wholly or partially any or all the bids without assigning any reason, whatsoever. The Employer shall determine, to its satisfaction, whether the Bidder that is selected as having submitted the optimal and substantially responsive bid, meets the qualifying criteria.
